Congratulations on your acceptance to the University of North Texas for Fall 2012! All new North Texans are required to attend orientation before they can register and actually attend classes. During orientation, you will have the opportunity to learn about campus resources, receive academic advising, register for classes, and interact with your fellow peers.

There are several orientation options for new transfer students. Please read the descriptions of these options in this brochure and select the option that best meets your needs. Regardless of your choice, orientation will provide you with the necessary tools to successfully transition to UNT.

Register for Orientation

Orientation reservations can be made by logging on to my.unt.edu with your EUID and password. Click "Student Center," then "Register for Orientation." Only those sessions with space still available will appear.

Transient Students

A transient student is an undergraduate student who has been enrolled at another college or university who plans to attend UNT for one long term/semester only and then return to the college or university where previously enrolled. Transient students are expected to complete an online orientation. Information regarding this online orientation is found in the Admissions packet.

What to Bring to Orientation

1. Copy of evaluated transcripts received from UNT with acceptance letter
2. Acceptance evaluation issued by the Admissions Office
3. Picture ID
4. Current class schedule and course descriptions as listed in catalog of classes for classes that have not appeared on most recent transcript
5. Cash, check, credit card (Visa, MasterCard, and Discover) or money order for tuition and fees
6. Award letter for Financial Aid & Scholarship recipients
7. All pertinent correspondence from UNT
8. Comfortable walking shoes

Testing

Music

There will be a Music Theory Placement Test for all students majoring or minoring in the College of Music who do not have college credit for music theory. Students with college theory credit will be placed in theory courses with the consultation of their advisor. All College of Music majors should plan on taking a piano placement test during orientation.

Math

Students who plan to take a math course at UNT will want to make sure they register for the right math for their major and long-term goals. It is important to talk with your advisor about this at orientation. 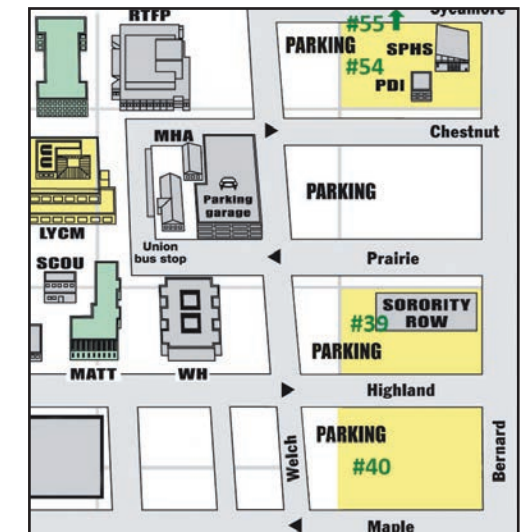
Foreign Language

Many degrees at UNT require some level of proficiency in a foreign language. The Department of World Languages, Literatures and Cultures offers an examination for both placement and/or credit in French, German, Latin, Italian, Russian, Japanese, Chinese and Spanish. If you intend to pursue a BA degree or some of the BS degrees in the College of Arts and Sciences, proficiency in one foreign language is required. Credit for foreign language can also be useful in other degrees. Please review your degree requirements at catalog.unt.edu to see if your degree requires a foreign language. For placement/credit by exam information pertaining to languages other than those listed above, contact the Department of World Languages, Literatures and Cultures at 940-565-2404. You can earn up to 14 hours of academic credit in foreign language through this test.

Disability Accommodations

Texas Success Initiative

All undergraduate students who enter a Texas public institution of higher education **must take one of the state-approved college readiness tests (ASSET, THEA, COMPASS, or ACCUPLACER) prior to enrolling in any collegiate-level coursework, unless they meet the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board exemptions** in accordance with Texas Law. Exemptions may be granted based on high SAT, ACT, or TAKS scores OR prior military service OR previous college coursework. Questions? Paying for Classes

Meningitis Vaccination

All new students must provide evidence of vaccination against bacterial meningitis or must qualify for one of the two permissible exemptions prior to beginning classes at UNT.
