# Eagle Fire Chili Cook-off

## Official Rules

1. **Chili must be cooked on site** - All chili must be cooked from scratch on site the day of the cook-off. No ingredients may be pre-cooked. Ingredients may be pre-cut and/or marinated ahead of time, but not cooked in any way. (Fillers, chili powder, beans, etc. will be permitted.)
2. **Supplies** - All teams are responsible for supplying all of their own cooking utensils, camp stoves, etc. A table and chairs will be provided for teams that pre-register before Friday at noon. No electrical outlets will be provided.
3. **Parking** - Supply drop-off will be located at Victory Plaza (the field south of Victory Hall and east of the intramural fields). Participants may pull up to the designated area and drop off supplies and/or equipment but must then move their vehicles to an appropriate paid area as designated by UNTPD.
4. **Judging** - Each team must have a minimum of 1.5 quarts of chili ready for judging in order to be eligible. Teams may prepare additional chili to give away and share with tailgaters. Each team will be assigned a contestant's number by the Chief Scorekeeper and be given a container in which their chili will be collected at the time of the official judging. Each contestant should verify that their number matches the number attached to the container before judging.
5. **Pyrotechnics** - No chili contestant may discharge firearms or use any pyrotechnics or explosives at the Eagle Fire Chili Cook-off.
6. **Winner** - The decision of the judges shall be final.
